


If Human activities are causing the rise in CO₂ levels why aren't the higher levels over the industrialised world?

If the highest levels of CO₂ are over the densely forested non- industrialised Amazon basin and sub-tropical Africa why aren't higher levels of CO₂ a good thing?

Why do we want to make CO₂ levels lower? The map shows that levels around 360 parts/molecules per million are over the snow covered areas of Earth.
